Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Olney-Newton Link (ONL)

I have examined the accounts for the year ended 31 December 2014 on the attached income and Expenditure Report.

Respective Responsibilities of the Trustees and Examiner

The Trustees are responsible for the preparation of accounts. They consider that the audit requirements under section 144 of the Charities Act 2011 do not apply but that an independent examination is needed. I have been appointed to conduct an Independent Examination required by section 145 of the Charities Act 2011 and to report in accordance with the regulations made under that section. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts, without performing an audit, and to report to the Trustees.

It is my responsibility to:

- 2. Follow the procedures laid down in the general directions given by the Charity Commission under section 145(5)(b) of the Charities Act 2011 and
- 3. State whether particular matters have come to my attention.

The charity's gross income exceeded £25,000 and I am qualified to undertake the examination.

Basis of Examiner's Statement

This report is in respect of an examination carried out under section 145 of the Charities Act 2011, and in accordance with the general directions given by the Charity Commissioners. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity, and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes a review of the accounts and making such enquiries as are necessary for the purpose of this report. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

Examiner's Statement

Based on my examination, no matter has come to my attention which gives me reasonable cause to believe that in any material respect, accounting records have not been kept in accordance with section 386 of the Companies Act 2006, or that the accounts presented do not accord with those records, or comply with the accounting requirements of section 396 of the Companies Act 2006.
