## Goshen High School

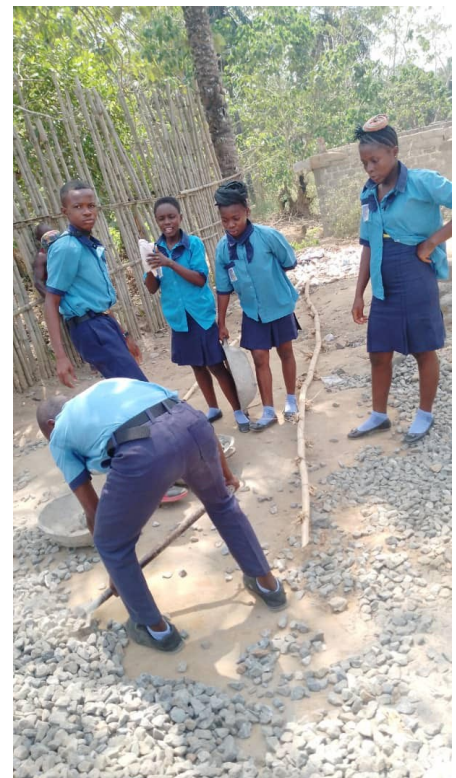
Ousedale School has established a link with the new Goshen High School. Mr Abdul Kabia (headteacher) sent the following information:

*The school building project is going on little by little. It will be 8 classrooms and 3 administrative rooms once completed. The toilet and the water well situation remains the same due to financial issues. The school is not funded by the government, but by individual giving and they have little money for labour (so sometimes the students do get involved with the work).*

*In positive news, the school did recently come first out of nine schools in a sports meeting.*

Ousedale have collected books to send out: some reading books, some Maths and Humanities textbooks. There are quite a lot, so they are going to sort them first and send those in good condition and those reading books with appropriate texts (stories of witches or ghosts aren't suitable). Mr Kabia said that they would appreciate anything at all that we can send out.


