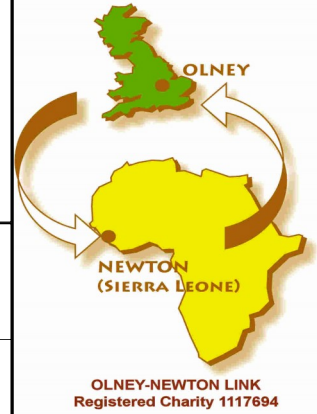

## News from Newton

Brima James Kabia sent us a WhatsApp message on 21st January to let us know that the Western Area (which includes the capital, Freetown, as well as Newton) is under a new lockdown and a night curfew. This is aimed to curtail the rapid increase in COVID-19 cases throughout Sierra Leone and will be for two weeks initially. Entry and exit from the area is restricted and only essential travel from Freetown is allowed, subject to a negative COVID test within 72 hours of travel. Restaurants and bars will be closed at weekends and masks will continue to be obligatory in public places.

Most of the cases in the country have been in Freetown. The country has had 77 deaths in total due to the virus. About 3000 people have had the disease confirmed (although not all with symptoms have been tested) and currently new cases are about 30 per day.

We have received £295 from those who entered the November Quiz - and £50 in donations.

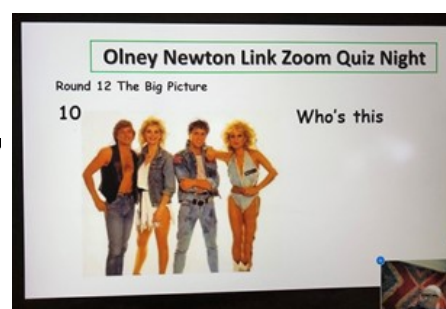
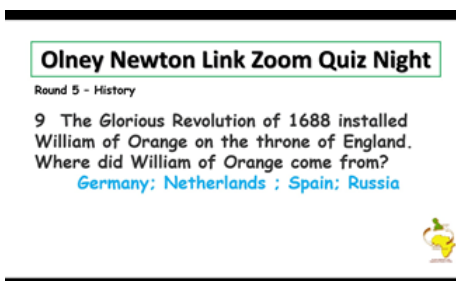
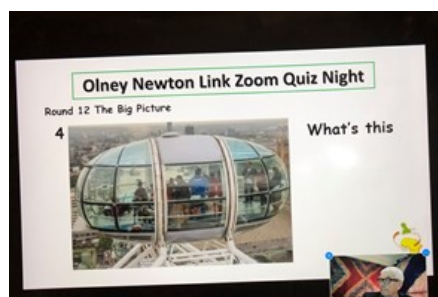
We have been given another £100 from Sue Lynch for face masks she has made. Super work Sue and thank you.

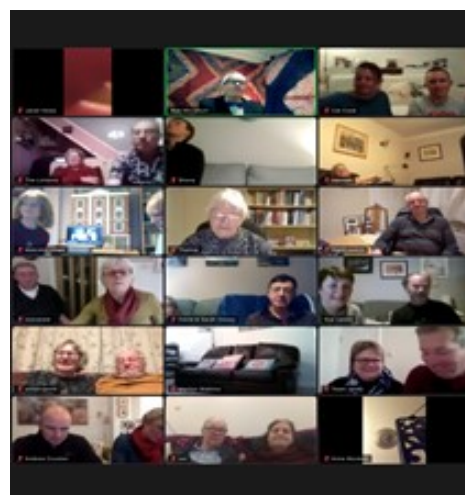
# The November Quiz
