# Goshen High school

Progress with the construction of the well has been rapid. It is now being concreted (the hole had been dug by the time of the last newsletter).

The procedure is to dig down until they find water so they know it's deep enough. If no water is found they have to try and find somewhere else to dig. Near a cotton tree is supposed to be the best place!

Note the steps left in the side of the well so that someone can climb down to deepen it if need be. Sometimes the level of the water table changes.

Wells are preferred to boreholes as they can be deepened and are less likely to succumb to blockages.
